Regulations

Tournament rules: Match Play (R&A – Rule 3.2)

Format: Individual Match play.

Play:

- On any 18-hole course;
- Play at anytime, anywhere, during the official time limits.
- Each player chooses their starting tees. Honour to be agreed or determined by the winner of a toss of a coin.
- The deadlines for completing rounds are those indicated in the published tournament table. In the event of force majeure, another date may be authorized by the EUGC committee.
- Players not completing their matches within the time limit may be disqualified.
- If a date cannot be agreed upon, the EUGC Committee will then decide the outcome of the match by either a toss of a coin or allowing the non-defaulting player to proceed.

Handicap – strokes received:

- The lower handicap player plays off scratch. The higher handicap player receives 100% of the handicap difference based upon the playing handicap of the chosen course and the starting tee.
For example: Player X has a playing handicap of 10, player Y has a playing handicap of 22; Y receives $(22 - 10) \times 100\% = 12$ strokes. The strokes received are distributed in the highest-rated handicap holes.

Conceding:

Yes, you can concede a putt, hole or match at any time. A concession cannot be declined or subsequently withdrawn.

Who wins a match:

- The player who leads with more holes than remain to play.
For example: 3 up, with 2 to play.
- The player who is present on the tee in the event of a “no show”.
- When the opponent concedes the match.
- In case of halved match:
The winner of a sudden-death play-off directly following the first 18 holes, starting at a convenient hole agreed by both players, and with the same strokes applicable at the same holes as during the preceding 18 holes.
